About KEVV - Evansville Regional Airport

The Real One

Evansville Regional Airport is a small regional airport located in the northern part of the city of Evansville in southern Indiana. Each year it serves on average over 200,000 passengers out of its terminal which has 5 jet bridges. Its primary carriers are Allegiant Air, American Eagle, Delta Connection, and United Express. There are a total of 3 runways, 18/36, 9/27, and 04/22, which recently was shortened to not cross 18/36 and was extended to the north east to make up for the length that was lost.

Evansville Regional Airport offers a variety of services including 100LL and JetA fuel, hangar and tie down parking, major airframe and powerplant service, and bottled oxygen. The terminal also provides a variety of amenities for passengers including a business lounge, conference rooms, wifi, and a restaurant.

I started the original development of KEVV - Evansville Regional Airport after a highly successful release of [KMGM - Montgomery Regional Airport - Payware for Free](#), and 5 months later, I released what was, at the time, my best scenery yet.

Over 5 and a half years later, in 2025, there was a bug report about a bump in the mesh. Upon investigating, I realized KEVV didn't quite live up to modern standards... so began a month-long project to revitalize the scenery. While the layout still uses the 2022 version of the airport, this update completely brings KEVV up to modern standards. The terminal has been largely remodeled, the ground textures fully revamped, hangars have been given new textures, new 3d people (that *actually* look like people instead of, whatever it was you saw before) are included, as well as new grass, taxi signs, and so much more! As with all updates, I'm thrilled to present this new version of KEVV free of charge to existing users!

 - Realistic large-scale, hand-made pavement textures
 - Ultra-high resolution decals for extreme close up resolution
 - Realistic markings that adhere to FAA standards
 - Realistic hand-made grunge textures and skids
- ✓ Living Airport
 - Realistic animated 3D people
 - Living Scenery Technology routes, with special configuration for collision avoidance and realistic traffic flow through branching
 - Native X-Plane service vehicles with custom models
 - Native X-Plane animated jetways with custom models
- ✓ Realistic custom grass and shrub vegetation
- ✓ Custom Ortho4xp mesh for realistic terrain contours
- ✓ Custom overlay scenery based off Alpitox's HD Mesh V4 scenery (used with his permission)

Installation

- ☑ Download “KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport Package V2.zip”
- ☑ Download “X-Codr Designs Library Package V<version number here>.zip”
- ☑ Unzip both of these files
- ☑ Copy “KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport Package V2/KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport” into your Custom Scenery folder
- ☑ Copy “KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport Package V2/Z KEVV Mesh” into your Custom Scenery folder
- ☑ Copy “KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport Package V2/Y KEVV Overlay” into your Custom Scenery folder
- ☑ Copy “X-Codr Designs Library Package V<version number here>/X-Codr Designs Library” into your Custom Scenery folder
- ☑ If there are conflicting files, choose to overwrite
- ☑ Open your scenery_packs.ini in notepad (or similar text editor), it is located in your Custom Scenery folder
 - Add the following lines to the bottom of the file:
SCENERY_PACK Custom Scenery/Y KEVV Overlay/
SCENERY_PACK Custom Scenery/Z KEVV Mesh/
 - If you have other mesh or overlay sceneries, instead place these lines above other mesh sceneries, but below other overlays. (if you aren't sure if you have other mesh or overlay sceneries, this step likely does not apply to you)
- ☑ Download and install [Living Scenery Technology](#) (see it's manual for installation instructions)

X-Plane 11 Support

X-Plane 11 is end of life – I *strongly* recommend updating to X-Plane 12. That being said, there is limited XP11 support for KEVV. After installing, please perform the following steps:

- ☑ Copy “KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport Package V2/XP11/KEVV – Evansville Regional Airport” into your Custom Scenery folder and overwrite the conflicting files when asked.
